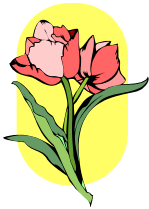

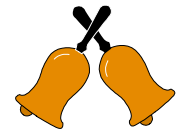

2 tubes crescent rolls
1 egg
2-8 oz. Philadelphia Cream
Cheese

Line 9 x 13 cake pan with one tube of crescent rolls. For filling, whip 1 egg yolk (save white for later), cream cheese, sugar and vanilla until fluffy and spread on top of crescent rolls.



Top with 2nd tube of crescent rolls.

Brush top with beaten egg white. Sprinkle with sugar. Bake at 350 degrees until golden brown.

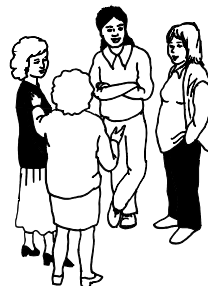

- 4/17: Apples, Oranges, & Bananas

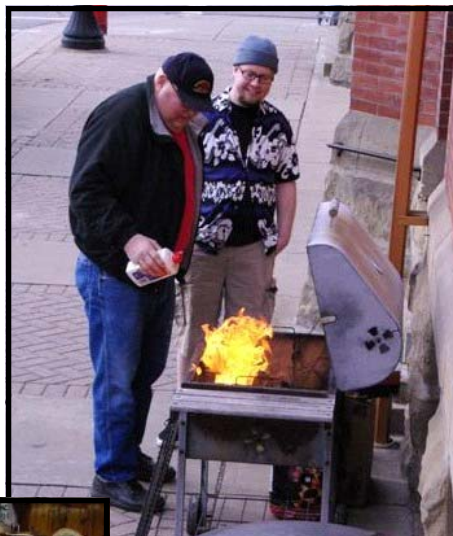

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION NEWS

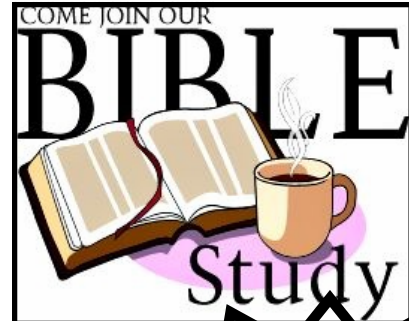
ADULT LENTEN BIBLE STUDY COMING SOON!
